This removes all contaminants and minerals from the water and enables us to achieve a smear free finish which can be easily maintained. The system also minimizes the amount of water required to achieve the result and provides the most environmentally sound option.

Ground Operated Reach & Wash Systems



Ground operated 'reach and wash systems' are the safest way of dealing with cleaning at height and when used with water filtration technology are capable of delivering the high quality results required.

Our systems can cope easily with heights of up to 60 feet and with the range of brushes available are able to clean window surrounds at the same time as the glass and be utilised for the cleaning of cladding, building trims and fabrications.

The pure water used in the cleaning process literally lifts the dirt and grime off the surface and with no need for chemicals is safe to use on adjacent material which having different properties to glass could be damaged if detergents or other chemicals were to be used.

Mobile Elevated Work Platforms



When the scale of the project or the geography of the site requires it Monthind has access to the full range of MEWP's capable of dealing with all situations.

These provide access to awkward areas where poles can't reach and provide a stable platform from which more detailed maintenance or work on fragile surfaces can safely take place.

As with all of the equipment we use the operatives using this equipment will be fully trained. Risk assessment and method statements will be prepared for every project.

Rope Based Access and Descent Systems



In some situations, particularly in high rise developments, access by rope provides the only solution.

Access is achieved by rope work utilising existing eye bolts and latchway systems or by abseil teams who work from the A Frames which they rig and are part of their mobile equipment.

This highly technical work is carried out by skilled and experienced professionals and as with all other solutions is only undertaken after a risk assessment and method statement has been drawn up, approved and committed to by all parties.
